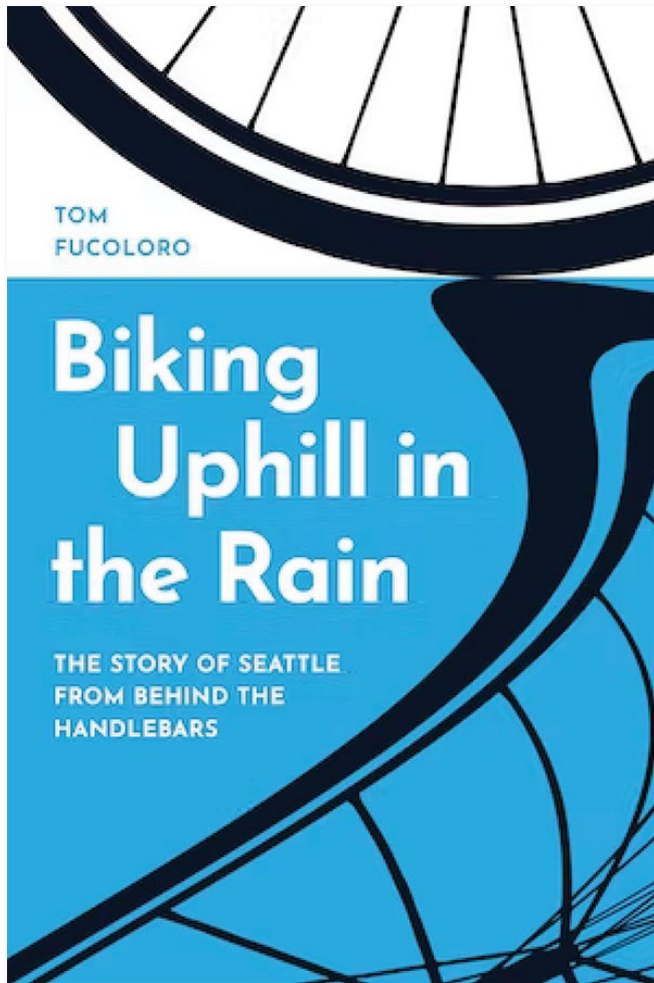


AUTHOR EVENT
